Abstract: From the settlement of Vörs (Somogy County, Hungary) 37 graves of a Langobard cemetery were excavated between 1959 and 1962. Altogether the skeletal material of 27 people was available for anthropological investigation. There were no children among them and the ratio of sexes was unbalanced, because there were three times more women than men. The stature was usually tall-medium/tall for both genders, and the primer taxonomical classification of the population was typically europid.
